



The White Lake Water Festival Pageant will be held **April 11th, 2026** at 5pm at **The Venue at the Grand Regal, 1564 White Lake Dr, Elizabethtown, NC 28337**, with contestants arriving by 4pm at the latest. On Friday, **April 10th, 2026** there will be a mandatory dress rehearsal at the Venue at 6pm. A required, non-refundable fee of \$150 is due via check to **White Lake Water Festival & Events, Inc.** The application and fee are due by **March 27th**. Physical applications & checks must be sent together to **2145 Owen Hill Rd., Elizabethtown, NC 28337**. All winners will be required to attend the 2026 White Lake Water Festival **May 15-17**.

AGE DIVISIONS & REQUIREMENTS:

All contestants will participate in the areas of competition of gown and summer wear, each accounting for 50% of the contestant's overall score. Summer wear is an age appropriate outfit of your choice. No swimsuits. Division winners will receive a crown, sash & plaque.

Tiny Miss: Ages 4-6; short Sunday best dress; NO pageant dresses, minimal makeup

Little Miss: Ages 7-9; short Sunday best dress; NO pageant dresses, minimal makeup

Junior Miss: Ages 10-12; floor-length pageant dress; full glam permitted.

Teen Miss: Ages 13-17; floor-length pageant dress; full glam permitted.

Miss: Ages 18-23, never married, childless; floor-length pageant dress; full glam permitted.

OPTIONAL COMPETITIONS:

There are 3 optional competitions that contestants can choose to participate in: **photogenic, best dress, & best summer wear**. Each optional competition has an additional \$10 entry fee. Please include the optional fees in your total entry fee check and check the boxes on your application for which optionals you wish to participate in. A physical 8x10 copy of your photo for the photogenic is due at dress rehearsal. Contestants may enter as many photos as they wish into the photogenic competition, with each photo subject an additional \$10 entry fee.

MAJESTIC DIVISIONS:

There will be 2 Majestic titles awarded: **Mini Majestic & Majestic**. Mini Majestic will be selected among Tinys & Littles; Majestic will be selected among Juniors & Teens. Miss contestants are ineligible, since the **Miss winner is awarded a scholarship**. To compete for Majestic, contestants **must also participate in all 3 optionals**. There will be no double-crowning. If a contestant is both the highest scorer in her division and the majestic winner, she will be crowned the higher title of Majestic.





For opening number, contestants will wear a tshirt provided by the pageant at dress rehearsal, paired with **blue denim bottoms** – this can be jeans or an appropriate skirt or shorts.

Contestants can wear a **white or nude shoe of their choice**.

There will be a **People's Choice award winner**. Votes will be \$1 a vote. Votes can be obtained prior to the pageant. People's Choice money obtained before the pageant will be due at dress rehearsal the night before the pageant with the attached People's Choice sheet filled out. People's Choice votes will continue to be collected during the pageant, and voting will close upon the ending of Intermission.

There will be an overall **Ad Sales winner**. The contestant who sells the most ads in the entire pageant will be named the winner. Ads will be included in the official program book and come in various sizes and prices.
